

Chinese Government Scholarship-Great Wall Program

Great Wall Program is a full scholarship established by MOE for the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) to sponsor students and scholars in developing countries to study and conduct research in China. This program only supports general scholars and senior scholars. The scholarship covers, in general, one academic year of study.

Eligibility.

- Applicants must be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China, and be in good health.
- Be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for the master's programs.
- Be a master's degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for the doctoral programs.

The Great Wall Program provides a full scholarship which covers tuition waiver, accommodation, stipend, and comprehensive medical insurance. You should apply to the National Commission for UNESCO in your home country and the deadline application will be between early January and early April .
