The Mawazo Fellows Fund offers grants of up to US\$2,500 to current MLEx Fellows and PhD Scholars Alumni to support their research activities. In order to encourage our beneficiaries to identify and prioritize their needs, each grant application will only support one specific research activity. Research activities include laboratory tests, support fieldwork, conference travel, specialized training, research translation activities, as well as support cross-sector collaborations (including placements at non-academic institutions). The research activity must be related to the Fellow's or Alumni's research (doctoral or postdoctoral) and they must be able to provide a clear justification on how the grant will support their research and/or further their professional development.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible for the Mawazo Fellows Fund, applicants must be either (1) past beneficiaries of the PhD Scholars Programme or MLEx Fellowship Programme or (2) current beneficiaries of the MLEx Fellowship Programme that:

- Have completed all MLEx coursework and submitted all assignments
- Submit an application within the respective dates of the selected funding cycle
- Are able to spend the grant within six months of receiving the grant

Cycle 2 of 2022 (2022-2); Call for applications opens on 4 April 2022 and closes on 29 April 2022, Cycle 3 of 2022 (2022-3) opens on 4 July 2022 and closes on 29 July 2022, Cycle 4 of 2022 (2022-4) opens on 3 October 2022 and closes on 28 October 2022
