- Abstract in Microsoft Word format Times New Roman font size 12, not exceeding 300 words
- Abstract to be single spaced and in italics; use the APA format, Key words should not exceed 6.
- The paper not to exceed twenty pages (20) of 1.5 line spacing using Times New Roman Font 12
- Where applicable the paper should include the sections: Introduction, Objective(s), and Methods, Results and discussion, Summary and Conclusions.
- Use of footnotes to describe the author
- Use of asterix to identify the main author.
- Authors to indicate the order in which they would like the authors' names to appear (applicable for more than one author)
