




# Kenyatta University Department of Psychology

## DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY (PHD) IN COUNSELING PSYCHOLOGY

### Program Overview

Students choose the PhD in Counseling Psychology from Kenyatta University for its academic rigour, its intellectual challenge and its proven ability to greatly enhance student career prospects both as practitioners and as researchers.

They are also drawn by the commitment of the staff in meeting individual student goals through a student mentorship approach.

### Program Requirements

Prospective students will have attained a MA degree in Counseling Psychology, or MSC in Clinical Psychology or Med in Guidance & Counseling or the equivalent from Kenyatta University or any other recognized university, with an aggregate B grade or its equivalent in the Masters course.

### Program Duration and Career Outlook

The program is scheduled to take 3 years to complete through coursework, practicum and thesis. We lay the theoretical foundation and empower you to be an effective practitioner as well as hone your skills in research. These we do within a multicultural context.

### Mode of Delivery

Our modes of learning are (i) Part-time (face to face) and (ii) Blended Learning model which integrates face to face and online learning experiences. Blended learning offers a platform to facilitate greater interactivity among students, as well as between students and lecturers.

Our progressive course materials are made available online through our Learning Management System (LMS) otherwise called the KUsoma platform. The LMS links you with our expert academics and course materials through videos, webinars, articles, journals, assessments and discussion forums.
